MEMBER VESSEL INSPECTION CHECKLIST

• EXTERIOR VISUAL INSPECTION UPON ARRIVAL:

- 1. New boats must arrive under its own power, either motor or sail. Vessel cannot be towed in.
- 2. Upon request all vessels must demonstrate the capability of moving under their own power. (if the boat is equipped with a motor, than they must demonstrate the capability of moving by use the motor)
- 3. Is the registration current and clearly displayed? If documented, owner must provide proof of documentation.
- 4. Is the vessel clean and in good appearance?
- 5. Is the deck free of debris and non-essential items?
- 6. Is the vessel well maintained with no signs of needing repair/maintenance?

• INTERIOR INSPECTION:

- 1. Check for bilge pumps and their operational status. Ensure bilges are free of oil.
- 2. Is there an operating head? If yes, ensure it is operational and connected to a dedicated holding tank.
- 3. Y valve must be tied off to prevent accidental discharge of holding tanks
- 4. Insert dye tablets and inspect for external leaks
- 5. Does it have a galley? If so, the stove must be permanently affixed. No portable stoves allowed. If the stove is gas fed, does it have an operational solenoid control switch and is the gas/fuel tank vented properly overboard?
- 6. If the vessel has a provision for AC shore power, does it have an AC circuit panel w/main circuit breaker?
- 7. Vessel must have the correct number and type of fire extinguisher on board, and they must be in good operating condition.
